The steel structure, wall and roof sheathing were supplied by Essex Structural Steel out of Cortland, NY and erected by Construx, Inc. out of Plymouth, NH. Radiant heat is piped throughout both buildings and the lighting design meets Efficiency Vermont Standards.
